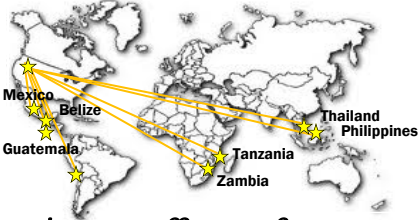

I want to take this opportunity to thank you for your loyal support of Mission Projects Inc. (“MPI”) outreach programs over the years. While these are financially challenging times, the Lord has continued to bless. Only eternity can measure the fullness of your sacrifices and prayers.

MPI’s main emphasis continues to be with Lay Workers. We currently support Lay Workers directly or indirectly in Belize, Mexico, Peru, Philippines, Tanzania, Thailand, and Zambia. MPI recently assisted a youth group that conducted an evangelistic outreach effort in Kenya.

MPI is also actively involved in assisting students in Mexico with funding to support their educational goals. San Lorenzo is a mountain village with a school that MPI has assisted financially for a number of years. Many of these graduates have gone on to be actively involved in ministry, health work or as teachers.

MPI continues to be quite actively involved with La Loma Luz Adventist Hospital, (“Hospital”) in Belize. Ruth and I have seen many challenges and opportunities at the Hospital over the past ten years. The loss of our dearly beloved ultrasound tech stands out as one of the most heart-breaking.

In spite of the bad times, the Lord continues to bless. Here is a list of some of the positive things that have taken place at the hospital or are anticipated will take place in the near future:

1. The new wing was completed and is very much in use.
2. The Hospital was given a new color coat of paint.
3. A 4 slice CT scanner was purchased.
4. A gift provided funding for a new used lawn tractor.
5. The Kitchen was upgraded. (There is still more to do.)
6. Dialysis was started in June 2010.
7. The Pharmacy’s physical plant was upgraded.
8. The Lab’s physical plant has also been upgraded.
9. Microbiology was recently added to the lab.
10. Dra. Lazo should receive her ultrasound degree in December.
11. The addition of a full-time Internist.
12. The assistance of a volunteer Podiatry group from Loma Linda.
13. The first phase of a security fence is in progress.
14. A school of radiology scheduled to begin in the fall of 2013.

I have 2 brothers; the dream of my youngest brother was to study at Montemorelos, but the lack of money in my family buried that dream. My mother can't help us very much because she has to take care my grandma too. I help her by selling books and I work at the University, but it's not enough.

I have no money anymore to keep studying and my mother is worried too much because of this. There are days in which it's difficult to eat. With the money I earn selling books I have two decisions: I keep studying or I keep eating. I always choose the first option. I can't lose another year, because I would have to start all over again from the first year because there has been a change in the study program. That would be disastrous.

Last summer the Mexican Army stole me, but thanks to God I was allowed to continue my studies. I get good grades and I'm hard-working. I do my best in everything I do; in school, colporteuring and working.

I love my God, I love my family, I want to help my mother, but I can't do too much. I believe in Adventist education, for that reason I'm still here in Montemorelos, I trust that my words won't go unnoticed. I believe that God will use you as an instrument of love.
